



**PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER RESPECTING THE NORTHWEST REGION
(Under Subsection 45(2) of *The Public Health Act, 1994*)**

Control of Transmission of 2019 Novel Coronavirus

WHEREAS, I, Dr. Saqib Shahab, an official with the Ministry of Health and the Chief Medical Health Officer for the Province of Saskatchewan, have been authorized by the Minister of Health to act under section 45 of *The Public Health Act, 1994*;

AND WHEREAS, the prescribed area of Northwest Saskatchewan (Northwest Region) commencing at the west boundary of the Province of Saskatchewan at 56.6 °N thence easterly to longitude 109.3°W thence northerly to latitude 57.15°N thence easterly to longitude 108.9°W thence southerly to latitude 56.9°N thence easterly to longitude 108°W thence southerly to latitude 56°N thence easterly to longitude 106.5°W thence southerly to latitude 55°N thence westerly to longitude 107.27°W thence southerly to latitude 54.2°N thence westerly to longitude 107.9°W thence northerly to latitude 55°N thence westerly to the west boundary of the Province of Saskatchewan and thence northerly to latitude 55.6°N as shown on a map appended to this order as Schedule “A” is or is anticipated to see a number of cases of exposure or transmission of COVID-19, which has been designated as a category 1 communicable disease pursuant to clause 3(1) of *The Disease Control Regulations*, increase;

AND WHEREAS the municipalities, recreational subdivisions, First Nations and other communities within the Northwest Region listed on the Government of Saskatchewan’s website, Saskatchewan.ca are subject to this order;

AND WHEREAS, the exposure to or transmission of COVID-19 is a serious public health threat;

AND WHEREAS, due to the situation continuing to evolve, I hereby rescind my Public Health Order dated June 7th, 2020 respecting the Northwest Region effective June 8th, 2020, and by virtue of the foregoing and under subsection 45(2) of *The Public Health Act, 1994*.

This order remains in effect until in the opinion of the Chief Medical Health Officer, there is no longer a public health threat.
