### COVID-19 Outbreak Declaration for Flying Dust Health/Administration Center

**Saturday, December 12, 2020 9:30HRS**

Northern Inter-Tribal Health Authority (NITHA) public health officials have declared an outbreak of coronavirus (COVID-19) in Flying Dust Health/Administration Center following an increasing number of confirmed cases. Contact tracing investigation is underway.

Anyone who may have been at this facility between November 30 and December 7, 8:30am to 4:30pm should self-monitor for any symptoms of COVID-19. These include: fever, cough, breathing difficulties, sore throat, runny nose, chills, diminished sense of smell, and body aches. If they develop any of those symptoms, they should self-isolate immediately and call HealthLine 811 or their community health center at (306) 236-8670 to arrange for assessment and testing.

Self-isolation is an important way of preventing COVID-19 from spreading in Saskatchewan.
