Precautionary Health Advisory - Increase in COVID-19 Cases

Northern Inter-Tribal Health Authority (NITHA) public health officials are advising northern residents to remain vigilant and take necessary precaution to prevent the spread of COVID-19 as more cases are reported across the province.
