COVID-19 Outbreak Declaration for Stanley Mission Health Center

Sunday, October 11, 2020 16:00HRS

Northern Inter-Tribal Health Authority (NITHA) public health officials have declared an outbreak of coronavirus (COVID-19) in Stanley Mission Health Center following an increasing number of confirmed cases. Contact tracing investigation is underway.

Anyone who may have been at this facility between October 5 and October 8 should self-monitor for any symptoms of COVID-19. These include: fever, cough, breathing difficulties, sore throat, runny nose, chills, diminished sense of smell, and body aches. If they develop any of those symptoms, they should self-isolate immediately and call HealthLine 811 or their community health center at (306) 635-2090 to arrange for assessment and testing.

Self-isolation is an important way of preventing COVID-19 from spreading in Saskatchewan.
