COVID-19 Outbreak Declared Over for Stanley Mission Health Center

Northern Inter-Tribal Health Authority (NITHA) is ending the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak declared in Stanley Mission Health Center on October 9, 2020. Dr. Nnamdi Ndubuka, Medical Health Officer with NITHA, has declared the outbreak over after the standard 28-day period has passed after the onset of the last case that had the potential to contribute to transmission in the Stanley Mission Health Center.

The public is reminded that during the COVID-19 pandemic it is important to continue to take precautions to protect yourself, your families and everyone who lives in the community. COVID-19 is present in Saskatchewan and we all have a responsibility to minimize the spread of the disease.
