## PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT:

### Potential COVID-19 Exposure at Northern Store in Fond Du Lac Denesuline First Nation

**Friday, November 6, 2020 14:30HRS**

Northern Inter-Tribal Health Authority (NITHA) public health officials are notifying the public of potential exposure to coronavirus (COVID-19) at the Northern Store in Fond Du Lac Denesuline First Nation where a person attended while likely infectious.

Although the risk of transmission to the general public is presently considered low, we are advising members of the public who visited the store during the specified date and time below to self-monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 for 14 days from the last date they visited the store:

- November 5, 2020 – Northern Store from 3:30pm – 3:45pm

Symptoms include: fever, cough, breathing difficulties, sore throat, runny nose, chills, diminished sense of smell, and body aches. If they develop any of those symptoms, they should self-isolate immediately and call HealthLine 811 to arrange for assessment and testing.

Self-isolation is an important way of preventing COVID-19 from spreading in Saskatchewan.
