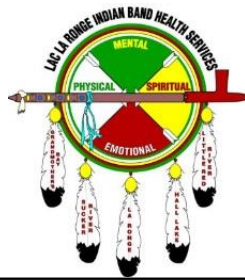

The Hands on Healing Support Worker position requires a candidate that lives a healthy lifestyle, is a good role model and has familiarity with the Woodland Cree Culture and Practices. The ideal candidate will be responsible for working with a Hands on Healing professional to deliver services in LLRIB communities. They will also work in collaboration with Prevention & Recovery staff, youth and community members, to strengthen and help create culturally relevant programming with the LLRIB communities.

Duties:

- Assist Hands on Healing professional with facilitating clinics in the LLRIB communities;
- Learn, practice and teach specific healing processes;
- Participate in gathering program statistics;
- Willingness to contribute in thoughtful and innovative way to the development and implementation of awareness and prevention programming;
- Participate in developing youth planning in each community;
- Assist P & R team/program in facilitating workshops;
- Attend required staff meetings, case conferences, and trainings as required;

Qualifications:

- Grade-12 or combination of education and relevant experience may be considered;
- Interest in and willingness to learn traditional healing approaches;
- Basic computer skills and experience with Microsoft Office;
- Excellent verbal, written communication and public relations skills;
- Experience in facilitating groups, public speaking, presentations; and writing reports;
- Experience working with First Nations people and/or organizations;
- Ability to speak/understand Cree is a definite asset;
- Must have a valid driver's license and willing to travel to outlying communities;
