Community Health Nursing Supervisor **Term - Employment Opportunity**

MLTC was created by nine First Nations located in north-west Saskatchewan who have constitutionally recognized aboriginal rights and Treaty Rights under Treaties #6, #8 and #10. The primary purpose of MLTC is to serve those First Nations in their aspirations for cultural, economic and political autonomy. As a private sector employer engaged primarily in promoting and serving the interests of the member First Nations, MLTC asserts its right to provide preferential treatment to First Nations people, giving them priority in decisions on employment matters such as hiring, and this can extend to measures such as opening competitions only to First Nations people.

- *Preference will be given to First Nation or other Indigenous applicants who possess the qualifications, knowledge and skills to meet the minimum suitability requirements as stated for the position*

The MLTC Health & Social Development Department is seeking a qualified Registered Nurse (RN) to fill the full-time, term position of Community Health Nursing Supervisor. Term ending March 2025.

This position provides support to the community and public health nursing programs in the Meadow Lake First Nations (MLFN's) by working closely with the MLFN Nurses; MLTC Nursing Management Team; MLTC Health & Social Development staff; the Northern Inter-tribal Health Authority's (NITHA); and acting as an MLTC Nursing representative to outside agencies.

This position is responsible to promote community and public health nursing practice standards throughout the MLFN's and MLTC; support effective immunization and communicable disease programming; participate in nursing recruitment and retention activities and evaluate community health nursing practice.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in nursing.
- The candidate must be currently eligible for registration with College of Registered Nurses (CRNS).
- Possess a combination of three (3) to five (5) years of experience in Nursing; Supervision; and First Nation Health Management/Administration.
- Will possess excellent interpersonal, time-management, and organizational skills; strong supervision/management skills; excellent communication (written/verbal) and presentation skills.
- Ability to work independently, and within a multidisciplinary health team.
- Demonstrated proficiency in computer software/hardware applications and programs.
- Will be knowledgeable and sensitive to First Nations' culture and beliefs; issues and barriers.
- Ability to fluently speak and understand Cree/Dene is considered a valuable asset.
- Must be able to travel to the MLFN communities, and regional centres.
